



## **Protocol for closure/re-opening in case of positive COVID-19**

If the Joplin Family Y is made aware that a member has visited the facility and has since tested positive for COVID-19, the JFY will implement the following steps:

The following are just guidelines as each situation is unique.

If a member has tested positive and has been in the YMCA within the last 2 days:

- Staff and members will be notified of the recent visit and the YMCA will close the doors to all, including staff, for cleaning. Notification will occur using social media and emails.
- Staff will clean and disinfect the facility. This includes all equipment, rooms and amenities. Staff will be provided with the necessary personal protection equipment.
- The facility will close until it has been properly cleaned. The JFY will re-open with the same precautions as prior to the temporary closure. This includes: staff cleaning equipment between uses, reminding our members through interaction and signage to wipe down equipment and surfaces after every use, promoting social distancing within the facility, limiting non-essential group activities, signage for our members and staff promoting frequent handwashing and asking members and staff to stay home if they are sick or experiencing symptoms.

If a person tests positive and has visited the Y and it has been at least 3 days since the last visit (this assumes the person was positive at the time they used the Y):

- As soon as we are notified, the staff will start cleaning and disinfecting the areas in which the person interacted.
- The Y will remain open through this process. Members will be notified and cleaning procedures can be shared.

If the Y receives a positive Covid-19 test from a child or staff in one of our daycare programs:

- The Y will follow all instructions and procedures set forth by the State of Missouri concerning positive cases in a licensed child care setting.
- If the Y was notified of a positive case that is more than 3 days old, the staff will clean and disinfect all toys and areas that children use without closing services.
- If the Y is made aware of a positive case within the last 2 days, the program will close and all areas will be disinfected and reopened on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day.
- In all cases, parents will be notified of any information regarding a positive case except for identifying information about the child or staff.
